



8th Annual Penn State Behrend "Spirit Against Cancer" Dance and Cheer Competition

PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS:

CHEER:

*Routines cannot exceed two minutes and thirty seconds. The music portion cannot exceed one minute and thirty seconds. If either amount of time is exceeded, there will be a deduction taken off the score sheet.

*A **spirit award** will be given to the top cheer team

*An exhibition round will be held during the final score tabulations.

*All levels of competition will follow UCA Guidelines (College Rules Apply).

*Items such as megaphones, poms, and flags are allowed.

*Two copies of music are needed if necessary (tapes or CD's are recommended).

*Routine choreography and music selection should be suitable for family viewing. (Please no swearing).

*All squads will compete against one another in the recognized categories specified on the registration form.

DANCE:

*Routines must be between two and three minutes.

*Props are allowed but not required. Teams may not use any more than four types of props throughout their routine.

*A **spirit award** will be given to the top dance team.

*An exhibition round will be held during the final score tabulations.

*Two copies of music are needed (tapes and CD's are recommended).

*All squads will compete against one another in the recognized categories specified on the registration form.

FUNDRAISING COMPETITION:

The school who raises the most funds for cancer research will receive the: "Top Fundraising Award." Enclosed is a pledge sheet.

REGISTRATION: Will begin at 8:30AM.

COACHES MEETINGS: The coaches meeting will take place at 9:30AM for the morning session and approximately 10:30AM for the afternoon session.

START OF COMPETITION: The competition will begin promptly at 10:00AM.

PRACTICE/WARM-UPS: Teams will have access to practice mats prior to the start of their performance. Teams will stretch and warm up according to the order of performance.

COMPETITION EXTRA'S: Photos and clothing will be available to purchase throughout the competition.

REFRESHMENTS: A concession stand will be available to purchase items throughout the day.

SPECTATOR ADMISSION: \$4.00 per adult, \$2.00 per student (Bring in any non-perishable food items and receive \$1.00 off the admission fee)

COMPETITION FEE: \$65.00 per team, \$15.00 per individuals
